Resources to flow from Arckaringa

THREE resources needed in South Australia – fuel, electricity and water – will all be provided from the massive Arckaringa coal-to-liquids and power project, its proponents say.

Addressing an SA Infrastructure conference yesterday, Altona Energy managing director Chris Schrape said the project had many benefits.

With a bankable feasibility study now in progress, Mr Schrape said the coal-to-liquids plant would produce 10 million barrels a year.

The integrated power plant's envisaged 560MW capacity would contribute significantly to the shortfall of 1000MW this decade, which has been forecast by the Electricity Supply Industry Planning Council, he said.
